


Preparing Your Tires

The type and rating of your truck tires will affect the handling and safety of your vehicle. Adding your camper, water, propane, and accessories impact the type of tires recommended for your truck. Small trucks like the Tacoma, Ranger, Frontier, Dakota, Colorado, and Canyon, and full sized 1/2 ton trucks like the Ford F-150, Dodge Ram 1500, Chevy/GMC 1500, Toyota Tundra, and Nissan Titan are typically sold with either "P" (Passenger) or "C" (6-ply) type tires.

Please check with your local truck dealer or tire provider to get their professional recommendation based on your truck and camper configuration. However, the typical recommendation is to use "D" (8-ply) or "E" (10-ply) rated truck tires.
